- The paper must be written in Microsoft Word using a defined font of Time New Roman.
- All papers must provide an abstract with 250 words, and be written in only English. It must include the title of the article, name, and surname of the author.
- Position, affiliation (Faculty, University) province, postal code, country (if not Thailand) of the author must be included.
- All papers accepted to the Conference will be published in a conference proceedings. The proceedings will be available online after the conference.
- All papers must be between 7,000-8,000 words including an abstract of 250 words, a maximum of 5 keywords, and references.
- All manuscripts should include the following sections:
 - 1. Abstract
 - 2. Keywords
 - 3. Introduction
 - 4. Research Objectives
 - 5. Literature Review
 - 6. Research Methodology
 - 7. Results
 - 8. Discussion and Conclusions
 - 9. References (**APA style**)
